

Membership: **FAQ's**



Q: In order to be a member do I have to be on Applied System's Support?

A: Yes. All ASCnet members must be current with support from Applied Systems. From our Bylaws: "Regular members – an insurance agency/brokerage using an Applied Systems product who is also receiving software from Applied Systems or their designate."

Q: How long does membership last?

A: Membership lasts for 12 months from the month of renewal. Renewal notices are mailed one month before membership expires.

Q: Does membership include local chapter dues?

A: Membership does not include local chapter dues.

Q: How can I find a local chapter in my area?

A: Go to the ASCnet website (www.ascnet.org/chapters) and follow the prompts to "locate a chapter in your area".

Q: What is MyASCnet?

A: MyASCnet gives members the ability to view and edit their records within our association management software. This allows for more accurate records on our part, which will benefit our members by guaranteeing you will receive all the important information ASCnet has to offer.

Q: Once I become a member, how long until I can get my User ID and Password to access the newsgroups?

A: User ID's and Passwords are available promptly after your payment is processed.

Q: What educational programs are available for members?

A: TENCon, our annual Technology, Education, Networking Conference, in the fall of each year and Regional Summits. These meetings provide you an opportunity to network with thousands of users. Information on these events is available on our website.

Q: As a member, do we receive discounted rates for the Annual Conference?

A: Yes! In fact, the discount for a member as opposed to a non-member is hundreds of dollars.

Q: As a member, can we get multiple copies of the ASCnet Quarterly news magazine?

A: The structure of membership allows for one copy of the magazine for each agency/brokerage. Agencies/brokerages that have a single license serving more than one office may purchase a mailings-only subscription (see website for details). The main office must be a member of ASCnet.
